6 Mr Gaffney to ask the Honourable Leader of the Government — With reference to the electric vehicle rebate scheme and the provision of electric vehicle charging facilities:

- (1) The Government's electric vehicle rebate scheme has been capped at 375 vehicles, all of which are currently reserved and all available funding for the e-Mobility Rebate for purchases such as e-bikes has been allocated.
 - (a) Will the Government open up additional rounds of the electric vehicle and e-bike rebate schemes, as it did with the successful ChargeSmart Grants program; and
 - (b) What is the distribution in terms of the numbers of rebated electric vehicles under the scheme in the North-west, North and South of Tasmania?
- (2) There has been no grant program for electric vehicle charging locations, as being only 204 electric vehicle charging locations, as Tasmania.
 - (a) What is the anticipated need for additional v increasing number of electric vehicles on our Tasmania?
 - (b) Will there be a third round of the ChargeSmart
 - (c) With the growing popularity of domestic sol been in Tasmania in developing bi-direec vehicle to home (V2H) and vehicle to grid power usage, utilisation and network load?

The Transport Emissions Reduction and Resilience Plan includes:

1. financial support for small businesses to purchase cargo e-bikes for last mile deliveries, and electric delivery vans;
2. no-interest loans for the purchase of e-bikes through the Energy Saver Loan Scheme;
3. a third round of the ChargeSmart Grants Program to install public fast electric vehicle (EV) charging in key locations;
4. pilot sites for secure bike parking, to support a sustainable and accessible transport network;
5. supporting the Australian Electric Vehicle Association (AEVA) National Conference and the Energy, Efficiency, Electric Expo, in Hobart in November 2024;
6. public education resources about driving electric vehicles in Tasmanian conditions, EV tourism materials, and resources for small business; and
7. funding to the automotive industry to develop a skills transition plan to support the transition to electric vehicles.

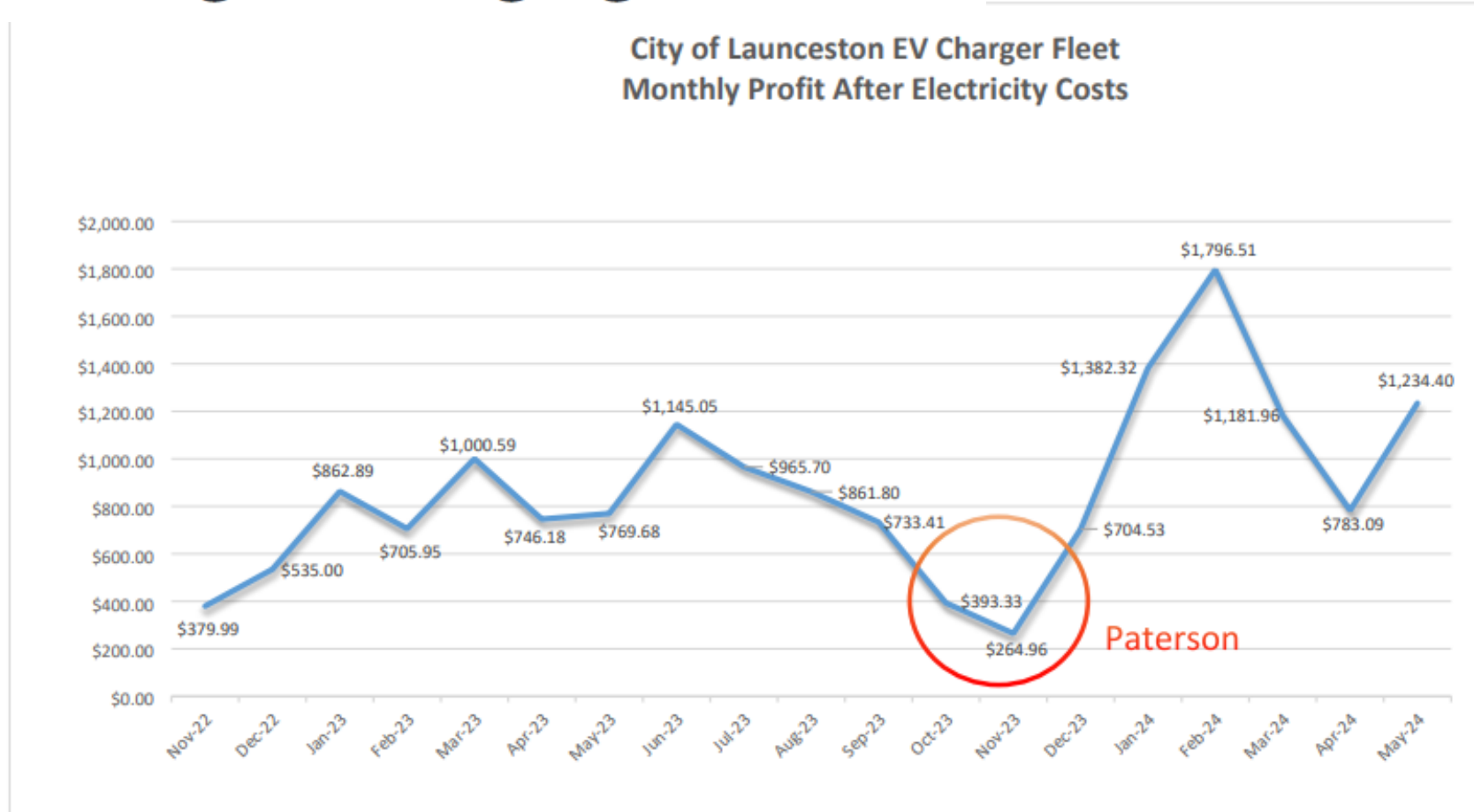
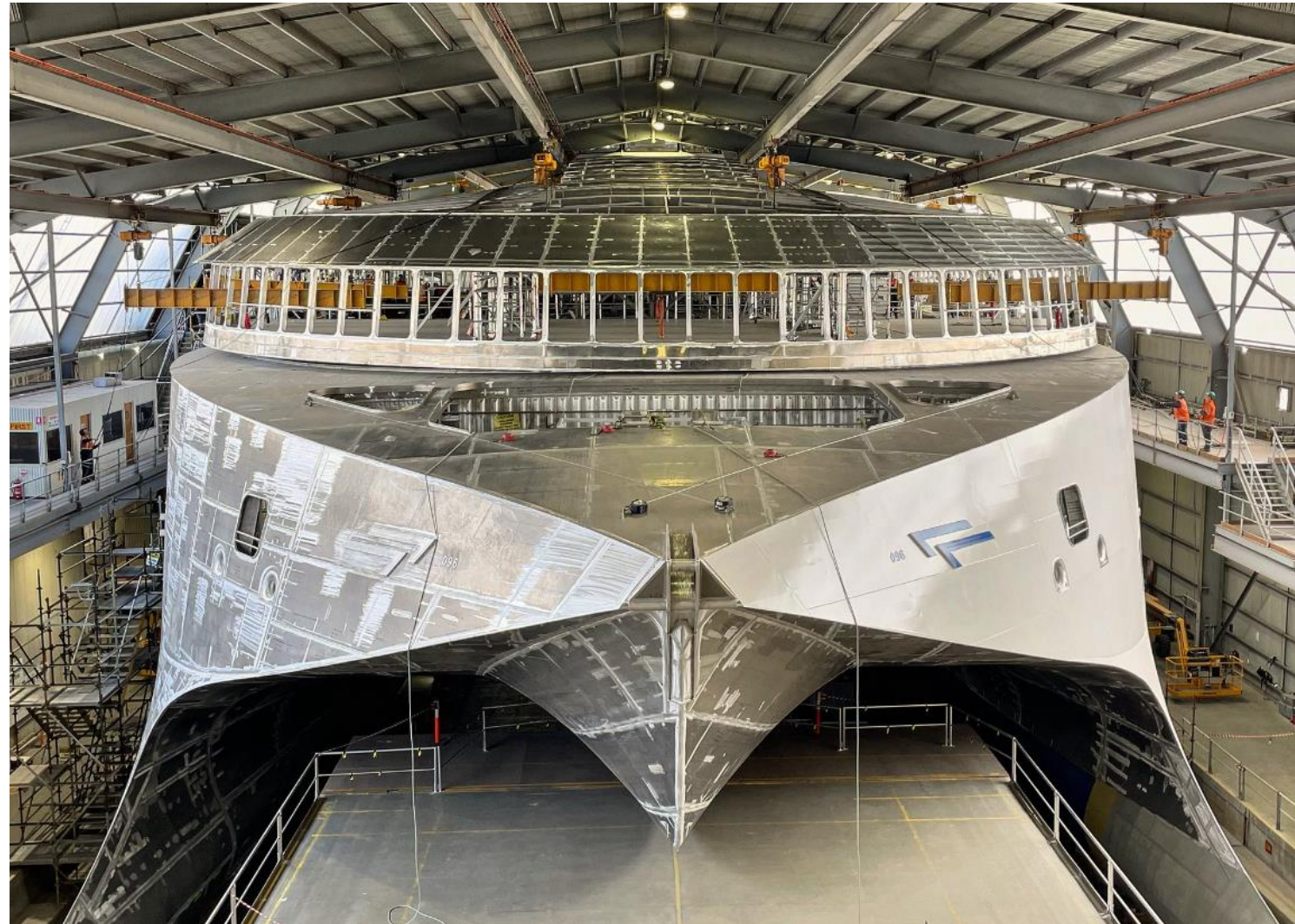


Figure 1: City of Launceston EV Charger fleet monthly profit after electricity costs. Excludes maintenance expenses.

Today marked a significant milestone in the construction of Incat Hull 096, as the final passenger deck module was lifted into place, signalling the structural completion of the vessel.

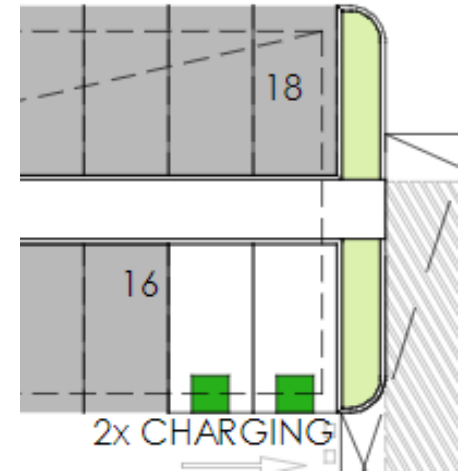
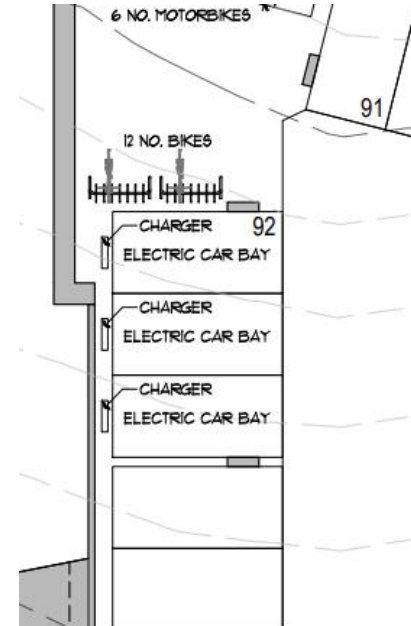
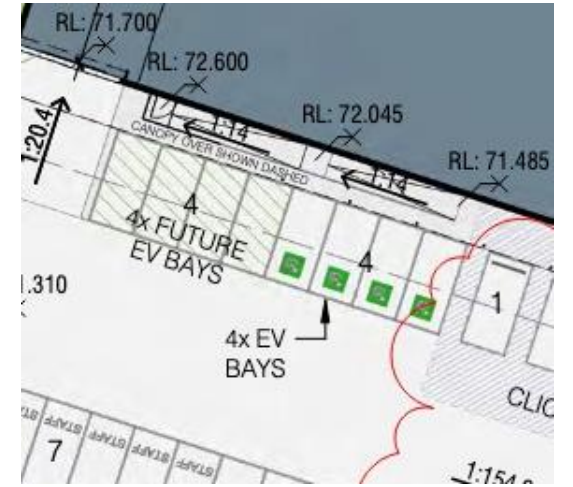

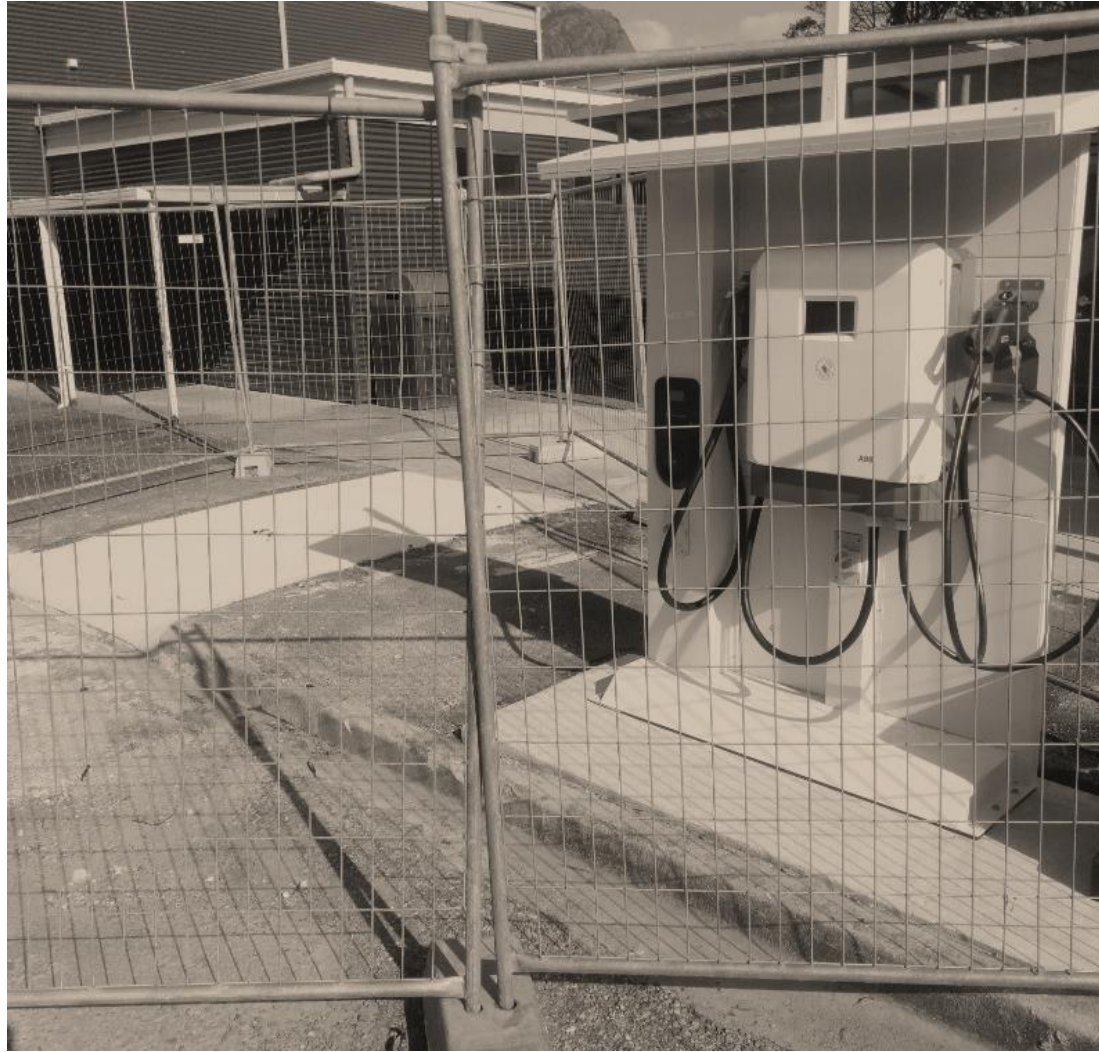
